



## ATTENTION ANGLERS

For any **tagged harvested** Lake Sturgeon, we ask for the tags to be turned in to the Lands and Resources Department at the Garden River Band Office. There are two types of tags that can be found on the fish; acoustic telemetry tag and a floy tag. The radio tags are small black cylindrical tubes that can be found implanted in the abdomen of the fish. Floy tags can be found next to the dorsal (top) fin.

Any of the following information taken from the Lake Sturgeon would also be appreciated:

- Length
- Weight
- Tag number (if visible)
- Location of capture
- Sex (Eggs or milt found)
- Date and time of capture
