Adult Sturgeon and Larval Drift Assessment

The Anishinabek/Ontario Fisheries Resource Centre (A/OFRC), in partnership with Nipissing First Nation will be conducting a Lake Sturgeon Assessment in the South River of Lake Nipissing in May & June 2022.

The A/OFRC staff will be setting short set gill nets and larval drift nets. All information gathered will contribute to the protection and recovery of Lake Sturgeon by identifying important spawning habitats and determining areas of the river utilized by larval sturgeon.





The A/OFRC is a not-for-profit organization that serves as an independent source of information for communities within the Anishinabek Nation. The Centre provides information and recommendations for sustainable fisheries management, reports of stock status, evaluates stresses on fish populations and habitats, and offers technical support.
