## Muskellunge Habitat Assessment via Acoustic Telemetry

Location: Pic and Black Rivers

The Anishinabek/Ontario Fisheries Resource Centre (A/OFRFC), in partnership with Biigtigong Nishnaabeg First Nation will be conducting a Muskellunge (*Esox masquinongy*) spawning and movement study via acoustic telemetry within the Pic and Black Rivers. The target of the assessment is to better understand the ecological role of Muskellunge within the watershed.
