Raynar Lake Northern Pike Presence/Absence Assessment

Long Lake #58 First Nation in partnership with the Anishinabek/Ontario Fisheries Resource Centre will be completing a Northern Pike Presence/Absence Assessment on Raynar Lake during the spring of 2025.

Beginning in May, Long Lake #58 First Nation and A/OFRC staff will be on the lake assessing the presence/absence of Northern Pike with nonlethal capture methods. The information collected during this project will help provide an understanding of the status and overall health of Northern Pike in Raynar Lake.
